

FEATURED BUSINESS IN WATERTOWN



Since 2000, ABS has leased space downtown. Over time they outgrew that 5,000 square foot facility. They doubled their space with this new building, with the ability to double the size again in the future. "We did not build the building for people to find us. We built it to give us more efficiencies and better access to our customers. The building allowed us to step up our inventory and have more technology in our system. Our paint mixing facility is state-of-the-art. Our loading docks allow for better inbound freight acceptance. Our shipping area allows us to load inside the building for



all of our four delivery trucks at the same time. The building also features a large meeting room where we can hold training seminars."

The Watertown location employs 11 people at this time.
